Itinerary: Spain and Portugal

Day 4-5: Sierra Norte of Seville

We wander through the golden landscapes of the Alentejo. In Elvas, we visit the Fort of Graça and enjoy a tasting at a local winery.

Day 12-15: Castelo de Vide and Marvão

We stroll through the Jewish Quarter, admire tapestries that tell stories, and marvel at the Lusitano horses, symbols of tradition and elegance. We explore trails leading to Portagem, where nature gifts us unforgettable panoramas.
