Itinerary: Morocco

"Morocco, contrasts and adventure"



This motorhome tour through Morocco is a true adventure that will take you from the Atlantic coasts to the depths of the Sahara, passing through cities full of history, wild nature, and a fascinating culture.

Day 1: Córdoba, Operations Center

Days 7-8: Marrakech

Days 9-10: Essaouira

Day 11: Agadir

Day 12: Tafraoute

Day 13: The Blue Rocks and Napoleon's Hat. Tarudant

Today we explore a surreal landscape, the Blue Rocks and the enigmatic Napoleon's Hat. These rock formations, remnants of a distant time, transport us to another world. We stop to admire the views and take photos in this spectacular natural landscape that seems to come straight out of a storybook.

Day 14: Taliouine

Taliouine is famous for its saffron production and is one of the main exporters of this spice worldwide. We cannot miss the opportunity to visit a cooperative of this exclusive spice.

Days 15-16: Ouarzazate

We arrive in Ouarzazate, known as the "Gateway to the Desert." We visit the famous Atlas Studios, where movies like *Gladiator* and *Lawrence of Arabia* were filmed. We also explore the 17th-century Amridil Kasbah, where we feel as if we've traveled back in time to the era of caravans.

Day 17: Dades Gorge

Dades Gorge, a spectacular canyon, offers a landscape of red mountains and uniqu rock formations. The view from the lookout is breathtaking, and the afternoon shadows slowly fall over the valley.

Days 18-19: Lalla Mimouna Museum and Merzouga

We visit the Lalla Mimouna Museum, where we learn about Berber culture and traditions, before embarking on a journey into the desert, riding camels to the heart of the Erg Chebbi dunes. We'll enjoy a 4x4 excursion exploring the black desert and visiting nomadic families.

Day 20: Erfoud and Its Fossils

In Erfoud, known for its prehistoric fossils, we explore museums and markets where these ancient treasures are sold. We immerse ourselves in the history of the land, admiring how nature has perfectly preserved these remnants of a distant past.

Days 21-23: Fez, Meknes and Volubilis

We visit Fez and Meknes, two of the four Morocco's imperial cities, with its well-preserved Medina, monumental gates, and the majestic Royal Palace. We also visit Volubilis, the best-preserved Roman ruins in the country, where we walk among the remains of temples and villas.

Day 24: Chefchaouen

As the tour comes to an end, the road takes us to Chefchaouen, Morocco's famous "blue city." We stroll through its labyrinth of cobbled streets, where the blue-painted houses envelop us in a calm and colorful atmosphere. We take the opportunity to do some last-minute shopping at the local craft markets, enjoying the art and culture of the region.
