

Itinerary: Morocco by motorhome

“Morocco, All in One”



This motorhome journey through Morocco is a true adventure that takes you from the Atlantic coastline to the depths of the Sahara, passing through historic cities, wild nature and a fascinating culture.

A circular tour where we leave nothing unexplored.

An experience you will never forget!

Day 1: Welcome in La Guijarrosa

We begin this great adventure together with a warm and friendly presentation, where everyone starts getting to know each other. The tapas dinner gives us our first special moment: smiles, excitement, and that wonderful feeling of knowing that almost four weeks of discovery lie ahead.

Day 2: Córdoba – A Living Jewel

We dive into Córdoba with a local guide who opens the doors to its history. The Mosque–Cathedral leaves you speechless, a place where time seems to stand still. Walking through the old town—patios, narrow streets, and Andalusian aromas—awakens the traveler within us.

Day 3: Last Night in Europe – Tarifa

We leave La Guijarrosa heading to Tarifa, a coastal town where the wind carries stories from North Africa. Strolling through its streets, feeling the maritime atmosphere, and watching the horizon knowing that tomorrow we cross to another continent... it's pure emotion.

Day 4: Crossing the Strait – Welcome to Morocco!

The ferry crossing marks the real beginning of the journey. You leave Spain behind, and in less than an hour you're in Tangier Med. A new rhythm and new colors welcome you. We drive to Kenitra and end the day with a welcome dinner that tastes like the start of a new chapter.

Day 5: Rabat – Elegance on the Atlantic

Rabat greets us with a beautiful blend of tradition and modernity. We visit its most iconic landmarks: ancient walls, a serene medina, and its peaceful coastline. A capital city that surprises with its calm beauty and refined charm.

Day 6: Casablanca – Modernity and Spirituality

Today we discover Casablanca, a vibrant city where the Hassan II Mosque dominates the skyline with an elegance that's impossible to ignore. Its architecture, its location right on the ocean... it's one of those places that stays with you forever.

Day 7: Heading to Essaouira – Wind, Light and Ocean

The Atlantic road takes us to Essaouira, formerly Mogador, a charming port city. Its white-and-blue medina, bohemian atmosphere and magical light prepare us for two days filled with calm and beauty.

Day 8: Essaouira – Pure Maritime Essence

In the morning we explore the city with a guide who reveals its Portuguese history, fortress and artisan culture. In the afternoon we visit an argan oil cooperative, where local women keep an ancestral tradition alive. Dinner closes a day full of authenticity.

Day 9: Marrakech – Journey to the Red City

We say goodbye to the Atlantic and head inland toward Marrakech. The feeling of arriving in one of the most iconic cities in the world is truly indescribable.

Day 10: Marrakech – Colors, Aromas and Life

We visit Marrakech with a guide who takes us through the medina, the souks, the monuments and that fascinating universe of lively alleyways. In the evening, we enjoy a dinner with show: music, dance and the vibrant energy of this unique city.

Day 11: Free Day

A day for yourself—to wander through the souks, sit on a terrace, stroll through a garden or simply relax. Marrakech has a thousand ways to win your heart.

Day 12: Ouzoud Waterfalls – Nature at Its Best

We arrive in Ouzoud and in the afternoon walk down to its waterfalls, a natural paradise where water cascades between reddish cliffs and olive trees. The sound of the falls and the landscape create a moment of pure tranquility.

Day 13: Ancient Villages and Local Gastronomy

We walk to Tanagmelt, a 17th-century village that seems frozen in time. The mountains, the silence and the traditional architecture connect us with Morocco's rural life. Lunch included.

Day 14: Skoura and Traditional Dinner

We travel to Skoura, an oasis filled with palm groves and ancient kasbahs. In the evening, we enjoy a *Couscous Royal*, lovingly prepared with authentic local flavor. One of those dinners you never forget.

Day 15: Ait Ben Haddou & Atlas Studios

We explore the most famous kasbah in the country, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Its passageways, views and history are truly captivating. Afterwards we visit the Atlas film studios, where legendary productions have been filmed.

Day 16: Kasbah Amridil and the Valley of Roses

A Berber breakfast to start the day right. We visit Kasbah Amridil, one of the most authentic in the south. On the way to Boumalne, we can stop at a traditional rosewater distillery, where the fragrance fills the air.

Day 17: 4x4 Adventure – Dadès & Todra Gorges

A magical day exploring two of the most impressive landscapes in the Atlas Mountains. Towering rock formations, winding roads and a tea break with Berbers in a spot that looks like it was made for postcards.

Day 18: Lalla Mimouna Museum & Night Under the Stars

We visit the Lalla Mimouna Museum to learn about Berber culture and traditions before heading into a perfect natural setting for an overnight stay. A night of wild camping... and a sky full of stars that takes your breath away.

Day 19: On the Way to Merzouga – Berber Photocall

Before reaching the desert, we make a very special stop: we dress in traditional Berber clothing for a fun, colorful and truly authentic photo session.

Day 20: Sunrise on Camelback & Luxury Desert Camp

Before dawn, we cross the dunes on camelback and stop atop a dune to witness the sunrise. The silence, the golden light and the endless desert feel absolutely magical.

In the afternoon we head by 4x4 to a luxury desert camp where we enjoy dinner, local music and a night in traditional haimas under a star-filled sky.

Day 21: Free Day in Merzouga

Rest, walk on the dunes, sunbathe, read, enjoy a fun quad or buggy session... The desert invites you to experience time in a completely different way.

Day 22: Fossils & Welcome Dinner

On the way to Er-Rachidia, we visit a fossil factory—an incredible place where the earth reveals stories from millions of years ago. In the evening, we enjoy a welcome dinner.

Day 23: Barbecue and Petanque

Today we enjoy a relaxed and fun day in Er-Rachidia. We share a Dutch-style barbecue and a lively petanque tournament with friends.

After that, you have free time to rest, go for a walk, or take a small hiking route around the area. A perfect day to disconnect and recharge before continuing the journey.

Day 24: Cedar Forest and Barbary Macaques

We head towards Moulay Idriss, with the option to stop at the famous cedar forest, home to the friendly Barbary macaques. A perfect spot for photos and a moment of connection with nature.

Day 25: Fez – Tradition and Craftsmanship

We explore Fez with a local guide who leads us through its labyrinthine medina, artisan workshops and a stunning historic madrasa.

Lunch is included, along with some free time to enjoy the unique atmosphere of this imperial city before returning to Moulay Idriss.

Day 26: Volubilis and Meknes

We visit Volubilis, one of the best-preserved Roman sites in North Africa—a wonderful place for photos and for imagining life two thousand years ago.

We then continue to Meknes to explore its historic center and a beautiful palace–museum dedicated to traditional Moroccan music.

Day 27: Asilah and Farewell Dinner

We arrive in Asilah, a coastal town full of art and colorful murals. Perfect for a peaceful stroll accompanied by the sound of the Atlantic. In the evening, we enjoy a farewell dinner to celebrate the journey we've shared.

Day 28: Return to Spain

Transfer to Tangier Med, ferry crossing and arrival in Algeciras. The tour comes to an end... but the memories and new friendships stay with you forever.
