

Itinerary: Tunisia

“Adventure and Magic in the Land of Ancient Empires”



A 29-day circular journey through Tunisia to discover hidden oases, ancient cities, endless deserts, Roman ruins and landscapes that look like something out of a movie. All while enjoying the freedom of your motorhome, with the safety and peace of mind of traveling accompanied by the SidiCamper team.

A unique route for curious travelers, history lovers and seekers of authentic experiences.

Day 1: Ferry from Marseille to Tunisia

We board in Marseille and begin a 22-hour crossing that already feels like part of the journey: the open sea, the calm rhythm of the ferry and the shared excitement of the group create the perfect atmosphere to disconnect from daily life and open the door to a new adventure.

Day 2: Arrival in Tunisia and transfer to Hammamet

We disembark in La Goulette among new aromas, colors and a different kind of light. After settling in at Hammamet, we share a welcome dinner where we toast to the landscapes, experiences and friendships that will soon arrive.

Day 3: Nabeul, souks and Mediterranean craftsmanship

We discover Nabeul with a guide who takes us through its old quarter, the Jewish neighborhood and its vibrant souks. The sound of artisans, the colors of the pottery and a harissa cooking demonstration immerse us in Tunisian essence. Lunch included.

Day 4: Zaghouan and Oudna: the legacy of water and Rome

We visit the impressive Water Temple and part of the aqueduct that supplied Carthage. Then we explore Oudna: its amphitheater, Roman alleyways and valley views transport us directly to Roman Africa.

Day 5: Sousse and Monastir: history by the sea

From Hammamet we travel toward Salakta and, in the afternoon, we discover the medina of Sousse (UNESCO) and the Bourguiba Mausoleum in Monastir. Ancient streets, fortresses and a bright blue Mediterranean accompany this day full of history.

Day 6: Kairouan and El Djem: spirituality and grandeur

We visit the Great Mosque of Kairouan, a jewel of the Islamic world that impresses with its serenity and architecture. Then we arrive at the amphitheater of El Djem, a colossal structure that seems to defy time. A monumental day.

Day 7: Route to Djerba, the island of peace

After crossing coastal and rural landscapes, we arrive in Djerba, a place where the light is soft and life moves unhurriedly. Ideal for disconnecting and beginning to feel the southern spirit of the country.

Day 8: Traditional and maritime Djerba

We visit Guellala with its famous pottery, the ancient synagogue and Houmet Souk, a lively market. Among aromas, trade and craftsmanship, we discover an island as welcoming as it is beautiful.

Day 9: Gabès and Matmata: life underground

We enter the troglodyte world of Matmata, where houses carved into the rock tell centuries of history. A unique landscape mixing Berber tradition, extreme nature and cinematic settings.

Day 10: Free day in Djerba

A day for you: beach, walking, shopping or a Dutch-style barbecue with the group. The island's gentle rhythm invites you to breathe deeply and enjoy.

Day 11: Guermassa and the desert ksar

We travel to Guermassa. In the afternoon, we optionally walk through its ksar on a hiking route among dry mountains and views that feel from another era.

Day 12: Chenini, Ouled Soltan and Hadada: fortresses in the sand

We explore three of the most emblematic ksar in southern Tunisia. Stone alleyways, wooden doors, ancient granaries and incredible views. Places full of history... and settings for famous film sagas.

Day 13: Ksar Ghilane – Oasis and adventure

We arrive at the heart of the desert: an oasis of palm trees and hot water surrounded by dunes. In the afternoon we ride quads to a Roman fortress. Ending the day with a bath in hot springs is an unforgettable luxury.

Day 14: Douz – Sunset on a dromedary

On the way to Douz, the gateway to the Sahara, we enjoy a dromedary ride at sunset. The sky turns red and gold as the desert's silence surrounds everything. An experience to keep forever.

Day 15: 4x4 adventure through the eastern erg

We spend the day among giant dunes, hidden oases and encounters with nomadic families who share their culture. An authentic day full of emotion and pure nature.

Day 16: Chott El Jerid and the Sidi Bouhlel canyon

We cross the immense salt lake of Chott El Jerid, a white and surreal landscape. We visit the Sidi Bouhlel canyon, an impressive natural setting where we take a short walk. Arrival in Tozeur.

Day 17: Mountain oases: Chebika, Tamerza and Midès

We explore three spectacular oases: palm groves, waterfalls, canyons and adobe villages. The contrast between rock, water and greenery creates an emotional landscape.

Day 18: Tozeur by carriage and palm culture

We ride by carriage through more than half a million palm trees. We visit the medina and Eden Palm, discovering the importance of this tree for local life. A soft and charming morning.

Day 19: Sbeitla and its Roman legacy

We visit the ruins of Sbeitla, one of the best Roman complexes in the country. Its temples, arches and stone streets allow us to imagine life in ancient Africa Proconsular.

Day 20: Dougga, African Rome

Excursion to Dougga, a World Heritage Site and one of the most beautiful Roman sites in the world. Its theater, capitol and valley views are truly memorable.

Day 21: Bulla Regia and arrival in Tabarka

In Bulla Regia we discover the curious underground houses, created to withstand extreme heat. Lunch included. We continue toward Tabarka, a northern jewel surrounded by mountains and sea.

Day 22: Mountains, forests and wild Tabarka

We visit Ain Drahem and Beni M'Tir, two towns wrapped in forests and humidity. We hike through green mountains and, in the afternoon, explore the most authentic part of Tabarka, with its rock formations and maritime air.

Day 23: Pure nature on the way to Bizerte

We walk along the Zeitoun River, among vegetation and clear waters, and enjoy an outdoor picnic. Then we continue to Bizerte, the oldest coastal city in Tunisia.

Day 24: Ichkeul National Park

We explore Ichkeul National Park, home to migratory birds and unique wetlands in the country. Then we visit Bizerte, with its port, its medina and its calm seaside atmosphere.

Day 25: El Alia Utica and arrival in Tunis

We visit El Alia Utica, one of the first Phoenician settlements in the Mediterranean. Between ancient ruins and nature, the day blends archaeology and beauty. Picnic included. Arrival in Tunis.

Day 26: Bardo Museum and historic center

We discover the magnificent mosaics of the Bardo Museum, one of the most important in the Roman world. Afterwards, we walk through the city of Tunis, full of contrasts and life.

Day 27: Carthage and Sidi Bou Saïd

We tour the Antonine Baths, the Roman theater and the cisterns of Carthage, one of the most influential empires in history. In the afternoon we visit Sidi Bou Saïd, a blue-and-white viewpoint over the sea. We end with a very special farewell dinner.

Day 28: Ferry back to Marseille

We board toward Europe with our backpacks full of memories, images and unforgettable experiences.

Day 29: Marseille – End of the tour

Arrival at the port and farewell to the group. An extraordinary journey that stays with you forever.
