

Itinerary: Morocco

“Morocco: Northern Imperial Cities & the Atlantic Coast”



History, Imperial Cities, and the Gentle Rhythm of the Atlantic

This route takes you through some of the most surprising corners of northern Morocco: cities steeped in history, imperial capitals, coastal towns with a strong maritime soul, and lush green landscapes that often surprise first-time visitors to the country. From the walls of Rabat to the Atlantic cliffs, passing through Essaouira, Marrakech, and the Ouzoud Waterfalls, you will experience an authentic, diverse, and richly nuanced Morocco.

An experience you will never forget!

Day 1 – La Campiña • Trip Presentation & Welcome Dinner

We gather at Camping La Campiña to present the journey, answer any questions, and share a tapas-style welcome dinner. A first night to get to know each other and start enjoying the travel atmosphere.

Day 2 – La Campiña → Algeciras → Tangier Med → Kenitra

301 km + ferry + 253 km

Drive to Algeciras, cross the Strait of Gibraltar, and arrive at Tangier Med. Our first contact with Morocco before continuing to Kenitra, a perfect city to rest and settle in. Welcome dinner and a relaxed atmosphere.

Day 3 – Kenitra • Guided Excursion to Rabat

We visit the country's capital, one of the most elegant imperial cities. Highlights include the Hassan Tower, the Royal Mausoleum, the old medina, and the photogenic Kasbah of the Oudaïas overlooking the ocean. A day filled with culture and beauty.

Day 4 – Kenitra → Mohammedia • Casablanca Guided Excursion

110 km

We head south along the Atlantic coast to Mohammedia. In the afternoon, we visit Casablanca, modern and vibrant, featuring the impressive Hassan II Mosque facing the sea.

Day 5 – Mohammedia → Oualidia

237 km

An easy drive toward one of the coast's hidden gems: Oualidia. Its calm lagoon, protected beaches, and famous oysters make this stop a delightful place to enjoy the Atlantic at its most peaceful.

Day 6 – Oualidia → Ounara

178 km

We cross agricultural fields and local towns until reaching Ounara, the perfect gateway for exploring Essaouira the following day.

Day 7 – Essaouira & Argan Oil Cooperative

Guided visit to Essaouira: its white-and-blue medina, lively harbor, artistic atmosphere, and deep connection to the sea. In the afternoon, we visit a women's argan oil cooperative, where we learn about the traditional production process. Dinner included.

Day 8 – Ounara → Marrakech

168 km

A pleasant drive brings us into the Red City. Golden sunsets, palm trees, ancient walls, and a unique atmosphere welcome us upon arrival.

Day 9 – Marrakech • Red City Tour & Camel Sunset Experience

Morning guided tour: medina, palaces, souks, gardens, and local life. In the evening, an unforgettable experience in the Agafay Desert: a camel ride at sunset followed by dinner and a live show in a desert tent.

Day 10 – Marrakech • Free Day

A day to relax or enjoy optional activities: a traditional hammam, gardens, museums, or simply getting lost in the souks.

Day 11 – Marrakech → Ouzoud

154 km

We leave Marrakech behind and head into a spectacular natural setting, toward the Ouzoud Waterfalls, the most famous and photogenic in Morocco. In the afternoon, we enjoy a guided trek along stunning viewpoints, natural pools, and shimmering waterfalls. A refreshing and authentic experience, perfect for connecting with nature and savoring the journey at a relaxed pace.

Day 12 – Ouzoud • Trail to Tanagmelt with Traditional Lunch

We begin the morning walking along rural paths toward the ancient village of Tanagmelt, **founded in the 17th century**. The route winds through mountains, agricultural terraces, and landscapes that preserve the pure essence of the most authentic Morocco. The experience ends with a **traditional Berber lunch**, lovingly prepared in a setting full of history, where time seems to stand still.

Day 13 – Ouzoud → Moulay Idris

340 km

We say farewell to the waterfalls and set off on a scenic drive north, crossing fertile valleys and mountainous areas. The landscape gradually changes until we reach Moulay Idris, a sacred city and one of the most picturesque places in the country, spread across two hills and rich in spirituality and symbolism.

Day 14 – Moulay Idris • Guided Excursion to Fez

Fez is living history. We explore its impressive medieval medina, a true labyrinth of streets, artisan workshops, centuries-old madrasas, and vibrant souks. Accompanied by a local guide, the visit is relaxed and safe, allowing us to discover the cultural and spiritual essence of one of the most fascinating cities in the Islamic world.

Day 15 – Moulay Idris → Asilah via Volubilis

230 km

Along the way, we visit Volubilis, Morocco's great Roman jewel, with its columns and monumental remains perfectly integrated into the surrounding landscape. We then continue to Asilah, a charming coastal town known for its white medina, artistic murals, and relaxed seaside atmosphere. In the evening, we enjoy a very special farewell dinner.

Day 16 – Asilah → Tangier Med • Ferry

71 km

Final kilometers to the port of Tangier Med. Time to say goodbye and return to Spain after an intense and emotional journey, with memories filled with colors, flavors, landscapes, and experiences that will last forever.
