

Itinerary: Morocco

“Wild Morocco: Atlantic Coast and Anti-Atlas”



Get ready to experience one of the most spectacular journeys through Morocco.

This 16-day route combines the raw power of the Atlantic, the charm of its coastal towns, the grandeur of the Anti-Atlas Mountains, and the authenticity of Berber life. A journey full of contrasts, vast landscapes, and unique cultural experiences.

An experience you will never forget!

Day 1: La Campiña • Group Meeting & Welcome Dinner

We begin the journey with a relaxed get-together among fellow travelers. Route presentation, a friendly atmosphere, and a tapas-style welcome dinner to set the mood. We start savoring Morocco even before the engines roll.

Day 2: La Campiña → Algeciras → Tangier Med → Kenitra

301 km + ferry + 253 km

Road trip to Algeciras, crossing the Strait of Gibraltar, and first views of the African coastline. After disembarking at Tangier Med, we follow a gentle route along forests, green fields, and northern coastal towns until reaching Kenitra. Welcome dinner to celebrate that we are officially in Morocco.

Day 3: Kenitra • Guided Excursion to Rabat

The country's capital welcomes us with its historic elegance: the Hassan Tower, the Royal Mausoleum, the Kasbah of the Oudaïas overlooking the Atlantic, and its blue-and-white streets. A perfect start to connect with Morocco's imperial essence.

Day 4: Kenitra → Oualidia

343 km

We continue south along the coast, crossing agricultural fields, wetlands, and ocean landscapes. We arrive in Oualidia, famous for its oysters and its calm, protected lagoon. An ideal place to unwind by the sea.

Day 5: Oualidia → Ounara

178 km

A pleasant drive between cliffs, dunes, and small coastal villages. We gradually enter a wilder landscape, always accompanied by the Atlantic Ocean. Ounara awaits us as the natural gateway to Essaouira.

Day 6: Essaouira & Argan Oil Cooperative

In the morning, a guided visit to Essaouira: the white-and-blue city where the ocean wind inspires artisans, fishermen, and musicians. We stroll through its UNESCO-listed medina and its lively harbor.

In the afternoon, we visit a women's argan oil cooperative, discovering the tradition behind this product and its importance to the local economy. Dinner included.

Day 7: Ounara → Aourir (Agadir) • Paradise Valley

183 / 220 km

A spectacular route through mountains, gorges, and palm groves. As we approach Agadir, we detour to Paradise Valley, an oasis of natural pools nestled among reddish mountains. Incredible views and a route that captivates every traveler.

Day 8: Agadir → Sidi Ifni

≈150 km

We head south along the coast, passing endless beaches and dramatic cliffs. A recommended stop in Legzira, where the sea has sculpted its famous stone arch. Arrival in Sidi Ifni, a peaceful town with art-deco architecture inherited from its Spanish past.

Day 9: Sidi Ifni → Tafraoute

175 km

We leave the ocean behind and climb into the Anti-Atlas Mountains. The road winds through arid plains, isolated oases, and striking rocky landscapes. Tafraoute welcomes us with its palm-filled valley and pink granite mountains.

Day 10: Tafraoute → Taroudant

153 km

In the morning, we visit the Painted Rocks and the "Napoleon's Hat," an almost lunar landscape. We then continue on to Taroudant, a lively walled city full of local life, authentic souks, and a very special traditional atmosphere.

Day 11: Taroudant → Skoura

290 km

A beautiful route through fertile valleys, palm groves, and striking color contrasts. We arrive at the Skoura oasis, one of the most beautiful in the country. We visit the Kasbah Amridil, a perfectly preserved 17th-century adobe fortress. In the evening, we enjoy a traditional *royal couscous* dinner.

Day 12: Skoura → Marrakech

243 km

A Berber breakfast before visiting the famous Atlas Film Studios, where movies such as *Gladiator* and *The Mummy* were filmed. We then cross the mountains toward Marrakech, passing through gorges, peaks, and breathtaking views like the **Tizi n'Tichka** with 2,260 meters above sea level.

Day 13: Marrakech • Guided Tour & Group Lunch

We discover the great icons of the Red City: Jemaa el-Fna Square, the medina, souks, palaces, and gardens. A guided visit that allows us to enjoy Marrakech without stress or getting lost. Group lunch included.

Day 14: Marrakech → Mohammedia • Casablanca Visit

262 km

We head toward the coast and, in the afternoon, enjoy a guided visit to Casablanca, modern and cosmopolitan. Highlights include the majestic Hassan II Mosque overlooking the Atlantic Ocean—a perfect blend of tradition and modernity.

Day 15: Mohammedia → Asilah

285 km

We travel north via the highway, crossing green fields, coastal towns, and peaceful Atlantic landscapes. We arrive in Asilah, a town famous for its murals, white medina, and beautiful sunsets. Farewell dinner.

Day 16: Asilah → Tangier Med • Return Ferry

71 km

Our final kilometers lead us to Tangier Med. We board the ferry back to Spain after a journey filled with landscapes, culture, and unforgettable memories.
